

IN THE FIRING LINE:

MEDICS SAVING LIVES AND LIMBS IN GAZA

More than 260 Palestinians have been killed and 28,000 injured, many with devastating gunshot wounds, during a year of "Great March of Return" demonstrations in Gaza. Among the casualties are health workers trying to save lives.

Dr Tarek Loubani, who was shot in the legs at the protests, and Dr Mahmoud Matar, a senior orthopaedic surgeon treating protestors' complex limb injuries at Gaza's largest hospital, will discuss their experiences and the wider challenges of providing healthcare amid the 12-year closure of Gaza.
