Duties and key responsibilities

- Develop and lead the philanthropy programme to secure income from active and cold audiences, with a focus on high net-worth individuals, new trusts and foundations
- Drive new business and prospecting to establish your own portfolio of major donors, giving £20,000+ per annum
- Identify new channels to grow major donor prospects/connections outside of the charity's existing networks
- Lead a strategy to maximise income from all major giving areas, seeking relevant opportunities and pursuing these opportunities to their full potential
- Develop and deliver tailored solicitations and stewardship plans, proactively improving knowledge capture and MAP's understanding of supporters
- Identify, research and cultivate leads to build a strong pipeline of prospects that will have a significant positive impact on income
- Develop and implement a range of cultivation tools
- Monitor, review and evaluate performance against strategic and operational plans, reports and financial forecasts
- Manage, develop and motivate a dedicated development team and work collaboratively across fundraising and the wider organisation.
